

The Littleton, Crawley, Kings Somborne and Stockbridge (16A) Taxishare

A public transport service for passengers travelling from Winchester back to Littleton, Crawley, Kings Somborne and Stockbridge

What is the Littleton, Crawley, Kings Somborne and Stockbridge Taxishare?

It is a public transport service for anyone who needs to travel from Winchester back to Littleton, Crawley, Kings Somborne and Stockbridge.

The service is similar to a bus service, except that passengers will need to book in advance and the journey will be operated by a taxi instead of a bus.

Where will I be picked up from?

The taxishare will pick you up from outside Winchester Guildhall.

Where can I travel to?

Pre-booked passengers will be dropped off at the following stops:

- Littleton Church
- Crawley, Hacks Lane
- Kings Somborne Church
- Stockbridge Church

When can I travel?

The service operates on a Thursday at the following times.

Journeys from **Winchester**

Winchester Guildhall	1130
Littleton Church	1145
Crawley, Hacks Lane	1150
Kings Somborne Church	1200
Stockbridge Church	1205

This service supplements the 16 bus service

What do I do next?

Firstly you must register with Hampshire County Council (this is free) by calling the number below.

You will then be sent the booking number to ring when you would like to travel.

How do I use it?

To use the service you must book your seat by 4pm the day before you wish to travel.

You can book as far in advance as you like.

How much will it cost?

All journeys	£2.00

If you have an older person's or disabled person's bus pass you may travel for free on this service.

Children between 5 and 16 years of age may travel for half price and those under 5 may travel free.

Accessibility

Folding wheelchairs and pushchairs can always be accommodated.

Other transport information

Winchester Dial a Ride provides door to door transport for anyone who finds it difficult or impossible to use ordinary bus services. For example you may have difficulty climbing steps onto buses, or be unable to walk to the bus stop. Please call **01962 852602** for more information.

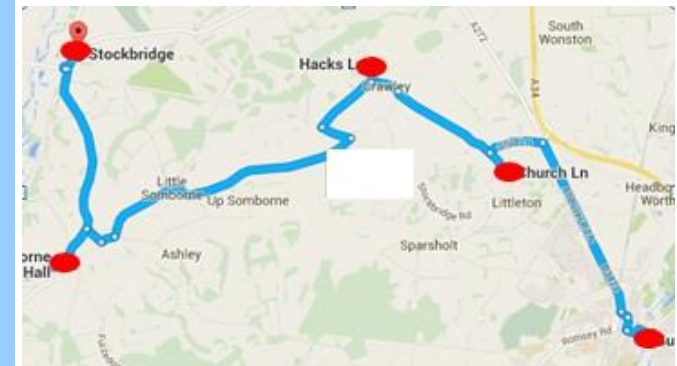
